

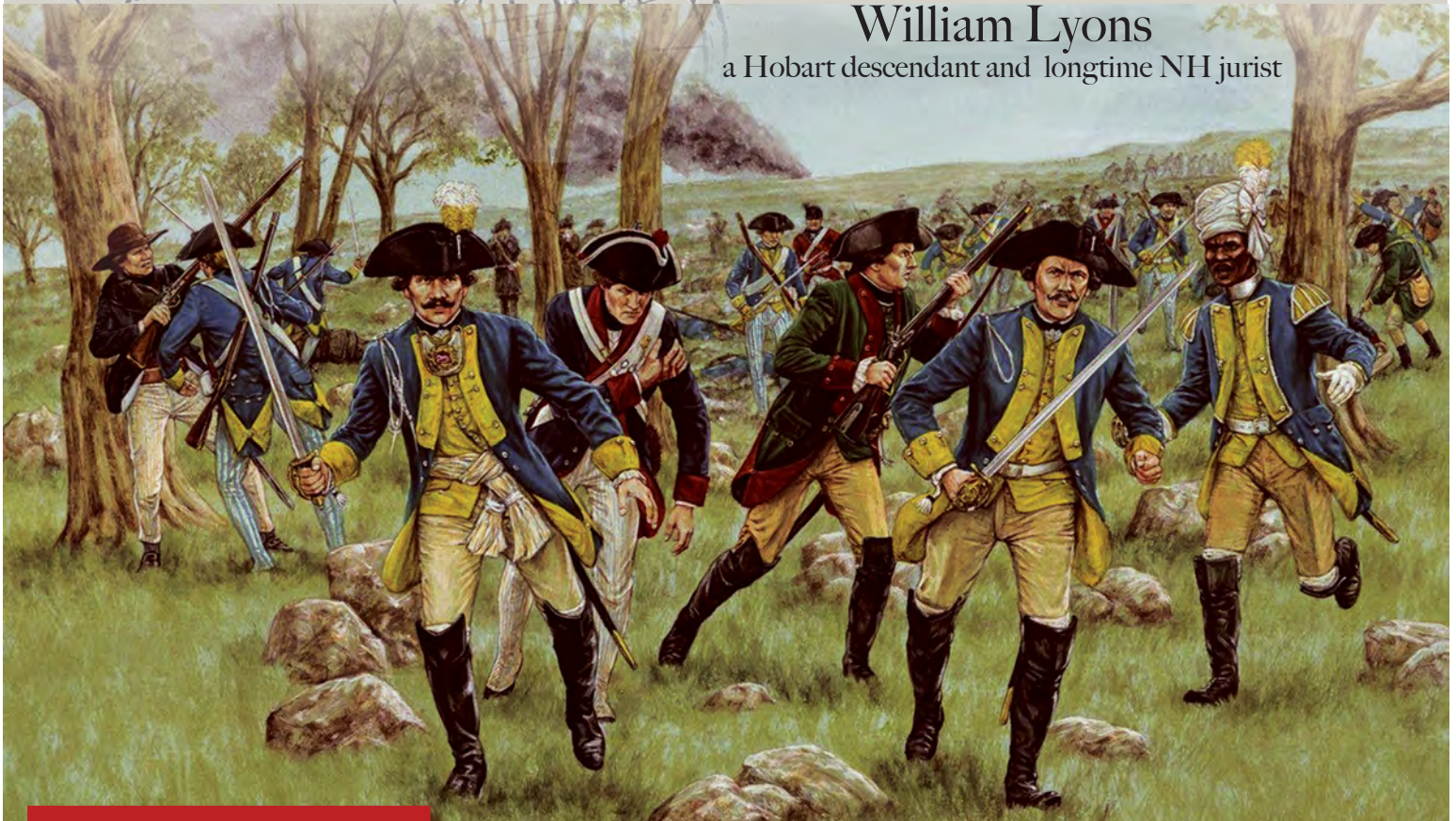

David Hobart was one of Plymouth's earliest settlers and a hero at the Battle of Bennington serving under Gen. John Stark. He was so admired and trusted here in Plymouth that he was a key decision maker in most early town business — laying out of the town, distributing original lots, planning roads, raising a militia, moderating town meetings, and settling disputes. He also helped plan the route for the College Road from Wolfeboro to Hanover. His brother Samuel was quite impressive as well. Join us to learn the whole story. Admission is FREE.
